How to Qualify for the EJCOA National Finals

The top girl and top boy in each age category from the North East Zonal will qualify for the EJCOA Youth Championships National Finals at Nottingham High School, Friday 7 July to Sunday 9 July, 2023.

Please note: Players may enter more than one Zonal.

About the EJCOA National Finals, July 7-9

This will be a 5-round FIDE-rated standard-play congress over three days (Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday), with competitions for Under 8s, Under 10s, Under 12s, Under 14s, Under 16s, Under 18s and Under 20s.

Time control: 90 minutes plus 30 seconds per move.

There will be various cash and trophies for boys and girls in each age category, and coaching and short lectures for all players between rounds delivered by experienced FIDE Trainers.

Other criteria for qualification for the National Finals are:

• By rating. Any player with a published current minimum ECF or FIDE standard play rating (as below) is entitled to enter the EJCOA National Youth Championships:

Under 8: 800 Under 10: 1000 Under 12: 1200

Under 14: 1400 Under 16: 1600 Under 18: 1700

Under 20: 1800

- Wild Card entries. These players will be invited by the EJCOA Selection Committee, based on a combination of:
 - a) Performance in an EJCOA Youth Championships Zonal.
 - b) Performance in other recent events.
